Conference on “One Health and Protection of Coasts: Ecological and Legal Issues”

The international conference “**One health and protection of coasts: ecological and legal issues**” was held on **3 October 2025** at the Museo Nazionale Romano, Teatro di Palazzo Altemps in Rome. Organized by the **Institute for Global Health Emergencies Response (IGHER) of the European Public Law Organization (EPLO)** and the **Law Department of the University of Urbino Carlo Bo**, in cooperation with the **OneHealthConference** and the **Global Pandemic Network**, the event brought together legal scholars, policy makers, and scientists to discuss the protection of coasts through the *One Health* approach.

The conference highlighted the interconnections between ecological, medical, environmental, animal, and human issues and showcased the relevance of applying the *One Health* perspective to strengthen political and legal decision-making. It also presented insights from the ongoing PRIN PNRR project “*From Beaches to Coasts: towards an Integrated Protection of the Coasts – BeProCoasts.*”
